### Instructions

The Modern Optimization Techniques retake-exam will take place online via zoom (ZOOM ID: 810 2469 0497) from 10:00 - 12:20 on Tuesday 2nd June 2020. You can join the zoom meeting will be available at 09:30. You are not required to visit University to appear in the exam. To make the process simple, we have provided a detailed outline.

#### A. What you MUST have:

1. zoom meeting id for this exam is ZOOM ID: 810 2469 0497 and <password> will be send via separate email to the students registered for the exam on LSF.
2. You must have a stable internet connection for the duration of the exam.
3. Your video and audio must be turned on for the whole duration of the exam.
4. Make sure the Learnweb is accessible from your mobile device.
5. You must install a working 'scan app' for scanning your answer sheet. Possible solutions that I tested are:
  - (a) the 'adobe scan app' from google play or apple store
    - i. google play: <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.adobe.scan.android&hl=en>
    - ii. apple store: <https://apps.apple.com/us/app/adobe-scan-digital-pdf-scanner/id1199564834>
  - (b) built-in function of Google Drive
6. Make sure the scan pictures taken at a right angle and everything is legible.
7. Test the installation of the 'scan app' by scanning a document (4-6 pages) and upload it on the Learnweb. The deadline for testing your setup is Monday 1st June 2020 untill 12:00.

8. The exam will be an open book exam.

## **B. Procedure:**

1. Join the ZOOM meeting room (ZOOM ID: 810 2469 0497) between 09:30 - 09:40. Give yourself enough time to accustomed/familiarized yourself with the room settings.
2. The exam will be published just like a tutorial question (it will become visible automatically at 09:55)
3. The exam will start at 10:00; you will download the exam and start solving on a piece of paper.
4. You will need to scan (see point A.5) and upload your solutions as a single pdf file. There will be two upload phases:
  - (a) The first upload phase will be from 11:00 - 11:10. In this phase, you must upload your first draft.
  - (b) The second upload phase will be from 12:10 - 12:20. In the second and final phase, you have to upload your final solution on the learnweb.
5. In any of the following cases, your attempt will be considered a 'failed' attempt if,
  - (a) Your internet connection drops for more than 5 mins
  - (b) Your video or audio remains off.
  - (c) You were unable to upload your solution in either the First or Second phase.
  - (d) You tried to contact another person via any means.
